We're excited to bring you some wonderful updates from Community Roots Collaborative (C-Roots)!

We are proud to now offer 44 housing units across two locations. Our newest addition, located at 3518 O Street. features seven twobedroom, one-bath "tiny" homes. These homes are now filled with families-six of which include small children. It's heartwarming to see new life and laughter fill these spaces.

Thanks to a generous donation from the Firstenburg Foundation, we've recently installed a gazebo and picnic table in the courtyard. Families are already enjoying this inviting space for gathering, play, and connection. Additionally, residents received a donated garden box, generously provided by **Chabad Jewish Center** of Clark County. The community is truly blossoming into a place of hope and positivity.



We're also thrilled to welcome a new service provider to Fruit Valley **Terrace. Live Love** Outreach has helped several new residents settle into our 21 tiny homes off Fruit Valley Road. One resident, Doug, shared that C-Roots and its partners have "given him some normalcy back" in his life-something he's most grateful for.

At Casa Hinojosa, four men-each formerly without stable housingnow have a place to call home. This converted house, once rumored to be a railroad station house, is full of history and new beginnings. The residents are settling in well and have even started planting a garden we look forward to watching grow.

All of our residents were formerly homeless before finding shelter through C-Roots, and many routinely express deep gratitude for the homes and support they've received.
